To qualify for the bursary scheme, the applicant must **complete a bursary application form and attach the following:**

- I. Copy of grade 12 mid year results or grade 12 results or grade 12 certificate;
- II. Copy of proof of residence in the Mpumalanga Province;
- III. Provisional letter of acceptance from a tertiary Institution or a copy of proof of acceptance by a tertiary institution ( this to be deleted as per Executive Management Meeting advice)
- IV. Copy of a South African identity document; and
- V. Proof of income of Parent or Guardian (If Parent/Guardian are not working an affidavit indicating reliance on pension grant is to be submitted).

**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:**

- a) Application forms are available in all the Departments of the Provincial Government including Regions and Districts, Thusong Service Centres and Municipalities.
- b) Completed application forms including all the attachments mentioned above must be submitted to the Provincial Offices of all the Departments at the Riverside Complex including Municipalities, Thusong service Centres and all school Districts and Circuits.**
- c) The Mpumalanga Provincial government reserves the right not to award a bursary.
- d) Successful candidates will be informed from 20 January 2012 after the Bursary Centralisation Committee has finalised the selection process and approval given by Head of Department of Education.
- e) If you do not hear from the department by the end of February 2012, consider your application to be unsuccessful.
- f) **Verification of Residential address and indigent status will be conducted without prior notification.**

The closing date for submission of all application forms is **30 SEPTEMBER 2011**
